

Predator Banshee



The Midnight's Spectres Space Marine Chapter is credited with the creation of the Predator Banshee as an infantry support tank. It is believed the tank is a redesign based on the Spectres rejection of the "Baal" pattern predator as an ineffective design. It is also believed that the Banshee is the basis of the Lemman Russ Exterminator variant (although some critics state the opposite is likely true). The variant is named the Banshee due to its high pitched howl when firing all its main armament. The rear mounted finned turret provides for additional recoil compensation using the weight of the tank to balance out the punishing lurching of the turret. While the Midnight's Spectres actively promote the Banshee as an improved design, it has not widely caught on and very few other chapters have ever been seen fielding them in battle.
